Feedback from Parents/carers	Parents/ Carers would like a wider range of clubs to be offered, particularly some clubs that offer activities other than sports, such as arts/ crafts clubs.
School Comment	Whilst we try to offer a good range of clubs, we do recognise they are generally sports related. We know not all children want to join sports clubs, so we will consider how we can widen our offer over the next academic year.

Feedback from Parents/carers	Parents/ Carers feel that they do not always know what their child is learning about in class.
School Comment	Whilst we have information about our curriculum on our website, we will look to share this information more directly with parents/ carers on a more regular basis.
