

What is it?

The Heathlands High 5 is a school reward for children who show an outstanding commitment to their education. It brings together several of our school's positive reward systems such as the collection of Value Points and the Reading Challenge. It takes place every term - three times a year (Autumn, Spring and Summer).

What can you do at home?

- ✎ Encourage and support your child to complete the Heathlands High 5
- ✎ If your child doesn't complete the Heathlands High 5 one term, please remind them that each term is another opportunity.
- ✎ Remember that the cut-off date for each Heathlands High 5 is as follows: 6th December 2024, 21st March 2025 and 11th July 2025.

Please be aware that the next term's High 5 starts immediately after each cut-off date.



How do you earn it?

To achieve the Heathlands High 5, you need to accomplish the following five actions each term:

- 1. Excellent Attendance**
(a maximum of two days authorised absence per term - no holidays)
- 2. Value Points**
(earn 40 or more Value Points, without any C2s or above or more than five C1s)
- 3. Reading**
(complete the Reading Challenge by reading 50 times or more at home - please refer to the Reading Challenge rules)
- 4. Uniform**
(wear correct school uniform, including black shoes and correct school PE kit)
- 5. Homework**
(complete all homework set each week)

What are the rewards?

Children who achieve the Heathlands High 5 are invited to take part in a reward event at the end of term. This will be voted on by the children and could include; an overnight camp at the school, a movie afternoon, an inflatable assault course, disco dodgeball or a water fight!
