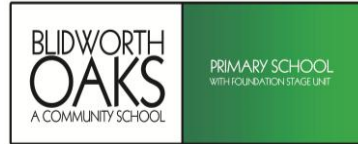


The Blidworth and Rainworth Primary School Partnership

Dear Parents/Carers

Year 3 will be visiting Creswell Crags Museum and Education Centre on **Friday 13th March**. This will be a fantastic trip aimed at our learning in History, where we are finding out about The Stone Age. We will be visiting a cave and learning about how people lived during this period in history. The children will also have the opportunity to handle artefacts from the past and explore the lives of cavepeople.

On the day, children will be leaving school at 9am and so we will need the children to **arrive at 8:30am** to be registered. We should return to school by 3.15pm. Children must wear school uniform on the day, but sturdy footwear, such as trainers or boots, should be worn instead of school shoes. All children will need **a packed lunch and a non-fizzy drink for the day and a bag** to carry everything with them for the visit. If your child is entitled to free school meals, we can provide a packed lunch if requested when completing the online consent form below.

We regularly enrich the curriculum by taking our pupils out on visits and subsidise as much of the cost as we can, however, in order for the trip to go ahead, we do require a voluntary contribution of **£15.00**. Payments can be made via the School Gateway app.
